About the Center

Under the direction of Professors Stacy Dymond and David Strauser at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, the Illinois Center for Transition and Work (ICTW) is a state-wide training and technical assistance center specifically focused on transition from school to work for students with significant disabilities. The ICTW is funded through a grant from the Illinois State Board of Education.

Our mission

To build the State of Illinois's capacity for inter-agency collaboration to support the transition from school to work of students with significant disabilities and become a statewide resource for best practices, strategies, and evidenced-based practices for special educators, vocational rehabilitation professionals, related services personnel, and school administrators.
