Functional Vocational Assessment



Functional vocational assessments, also known as situational assessments, measure student interests and skills when completing job tasks within the natural environment.



These assessments are useful for students who have difficulty understanding written or picture-based assessments, have limited onthe-job experience, and/or have unclear career interests or skills.



To get the most reliable results, arrange opportunities for students to experience a variety of jobs and work environments that match their interests.



Information learned from sampling one job or work environment can be used to select new jobs to sample until clarity is obtained about the characteristics of jobs the student prefers.



Ultimately, the benefit of functional vocational assessments comes from students developing job preferences while on the job, adding validity to the results of the assessment.

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
